NOTICE TO MARINERS

Great Yarmouth – River Bure Entrance

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that repair works to the quay wall on the south bank of the River Bure (opposite ASDA) and 40 metres west (downstream) of the Vauxhall Railway Bridge will commence on 1st February 2012 and will continue until 25th May 2012. During this period obstructions, including steel work, equipment and plant will project up to 3 metres into the river. Barges and vessels will be operating in the area and personnel will be working close to the edge of the works. The limits of the works will be marked by red flags with flashing amber lights along the extent of the works.

Navigators are advised to approach the area with caution, keep well clear of the works and pass at a slow but safe manoeuvring speed.
